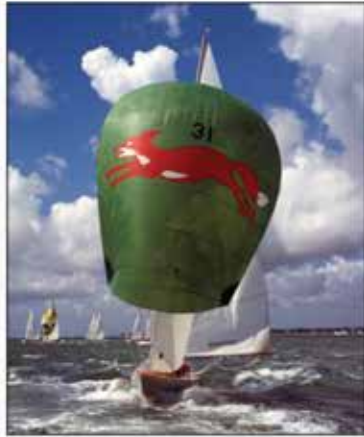

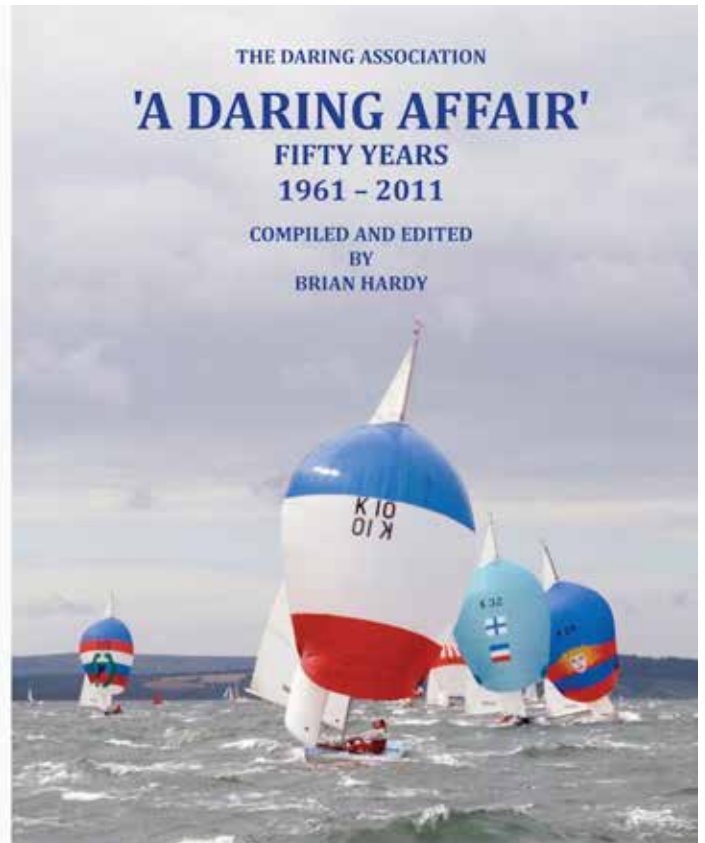
A DARING AFFAIR

The Daring one-design keelboat was designed by Arthur Robb in 1959-60, as a result of an initiative by Owen Asher, and his son Robin. The first boats commenced racing in Cowes in 1962. Fifty years later the class is going strong and has been recognised as the predominate day-boat class in Cowes for many years.

This book charts the 50-year history of the class and in addition contains a large section dedicated to the memories and stories of many Daring sailors from the past as well as the present. The Daring is considered by many as one of the most beautiful yachts in the Solent and is a wonderful advertisement for Cowes yachting at its best.

Brian Hardy was born in Surrey and educated at Gordonstoun in Scotland. He spent his working life in the Lloyds insurance market. His sailing career commenced with Merin Rocket dingies and progressed through Lasers, Finns, and eventually, in 1990, into Darings. Brian owns Destroyer (No 32) and lives in Sussex.
