



NOTICE OF RACE

The Stug Perry Trophy

23rd & 24th June 2018

Organising Authority: Royal London Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Safety regulations will be as defined in the CCCA Notice of Race.
- 1.3 RYA Arbitration will be available for this series and the Exoneration Penalty will be 30% scoring penalty implemented in accordance with rule 44.3(c).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to Daring Class boats.
- 2.2 Boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the entry fee of £60 per boat no later than Wednesday 20th June 2018. Boats may enter on-line at www.rlyc.org.uk

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 The series will consist of **six** races.
- 3.2 Normally there will be three races on each day. However, more races may be held on a day if a previous race has been abandoned or the forecast for the following day is poor.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The standard Cowes Clubs and Classes 2018 sailing instructions (SIs), including any amendments, will apply. The SIs are available on TeamApp "CCCA" and hard copies are available from the Royal London Yacht Club.

5. THE COURSES

- 5.1 Courses will be selected from the Laid Courses page of the SIs or using fixed racing and/or navigation marks from the centre pages of the SIs. The course will be broadcast on VHF channel 77 with the approximate bearing and distance to the first laid mark. Courses may also be displayed from the committee vessel.
- 5.2 Courses will **not** be texted. This changes SI 8.

6. PENALTIES

Penalties will be as stated in the SIs.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series. If fewer than three races are completed, the trophy will not be awarded. This changes Appendix A Scoring.
- 7.3 If four or more races are completed, one discard will be allowed. If fewer than 4 races are completed, then all races shall count.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction applies to all communication devices.

9. TROPHY AND PRIZES

- 9.1 The Stug Perry Trophy will be awarded to the first Daring overall. This trophy will be awarded at the Daring AGM and prizegiving in December 2018 at the Royal Thames Yacht Club.
- 9.2 Saturday and Sunday race day prizes will be awarded to the first boat if there are 9 starters, a second prize if there are 12 starters and a third prize if there are 15 starters. Day prizes will be awarded after racing each day only to the prize winners that attend the host club (RLYC) after racing on the day. Tea and cakes will be available after racing on the Saturday.

10. RISK STATEMENT

- 10.1 Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
 - b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their property whether afloat or ashore;
 - c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
 - d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
 - e) The provision of a race management team, committee boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.

11. INSURANCE

All competitors shall be adequately and suitably insured, as stated in the Declaration, before racing.

12. FACILITIES

Entrants are invited to use the facilities of the Royal London Yacht Club over the week-end of the Stug Perry regatta.
